A destination city excited for summer 2021

et ready to explore and go one step further when you discover Bemidji, the first city on the Mississippi. Set in the center of northern Minnesota, relax and enjoy urban life in the country setting where you can see fine art, enjoy incredible dining options and experience over 400 lakes within a 25-mile radius of the city.

Bemidji is a summer destination that ranks #1 in a few key attractions. Starting with one of the most photographed roadside attractions in Minnesota: the statues of Paul Bunyan and Babe the Blue Ox which have called the shores of Lake Bemidji home since 1937. Paul is 18 feet tall and he weighs two-and-a-half tons. Babe was added next to Paul in 1939. He weighs five tons and his horns have a span of 14 feet.

Another reason to visit Bemidji is because it is the first city on the Mississippi. You can find the start of the mighty

Mississippi just 26 miles southwest of Bemidji at Itasca State Park. There, you can walk across the source of the river. The Park offers something for everyone from bicycle and Pontoon rentals to educational opportunities. Lake Itasca and its park offers the perfect afternoon excursion when you plan your stay in Bemidji.

After a year off from the pandemic, Bemidji is excited to bring back summer celebrations and events are what Bemidji is known for. Starting with the 77th Annual Bemidji Jaycees Water Carnival, which runs from June 30th-July 5th, 2021. This 4th of July celebration includes carnival rides, games, food vendors, a water ski show, parades and the largest fireworks display in northern Minnesota. Bemidji also offers a large Art-in-the-Park event in mid-July, featuring artists from all over the Midwest. The spirit of competition also

comes alive during the 15th Annual Lake Bemidji Dragon Boat Festival August 4th through the 7th. It's not just about Dragon Boat racing: festival activities include great food, music, kids' activities, a parade of teams, cultural performances, camaraderie, and much more all along the shores of beautiful Lake Bemidji.

Bemidji also offers access to solace. It's where you can be one with nature in the "Lost 40," or go for a hike at the Lake Bemidji State Park Bog Walk or


enjoy a night of camping in the Chippewa National Forest.




